



Guidelines for Bass Endowment Submissions



The Forensic Anthropology Center encourages student within the Anthropology Department at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville campus to apply for funding from the Bass Endowment. These guidelines are designed to facilitate the application process and ensure individuals submit a complete application package to the FAC. Eligibility:

- Must be an undergraduate student with a major or minor in Anthropology or a graduate student in Anthropology, who is in good academic standing.
- Must be a faculty member with a formal association with the Forensic Anthropology Center.

Application Requirements:

- A completed and signed application form must accompany all proposals to be reviewed.
- A Curriculum Vita with references listed
- A research proposal

Proposal:

Only research proposals that have a clearly stated forensic focus will be accepted. The proposed research for which funding is being sought will determine the structure of the proposal. Questions relating to proposal requirements and inclusions should be directed to Dr. Lee Meadows Jantz.

A research proposal should include:

- an introduction stating the purpose of the project and its relevance to forensic anthropology.
- a literature review demonstrating appropriate knowledge of the researcher(s).
- an itemized budget.
- a budget justification.
