



Forensic Anthropology Center Summer Internship Application 2018



The Forensic Anthropology Center is pleased to offer an unpaid, non-credit summer internship for non-UT students. Interns will be expected to reside in the Knoxville area (University Housing is offered or interns can stay off-campus on their own) through the duration of the program. The internship interval is from May 29 – June 29, 2018.

Intern Responsibilities:

Primary responsibilities will be assisting with daily operations of the Forensic Anthropology Center, aiding with the professional development short courses, and processing skeletal remains for the Bass Collection, including the cleaning and labeling of human remains. Other tasks are, but not limited to, the body donation program, data entry, and daily tasks assigned by the supervisor. There is no curriculum *per se* but flexibility is a requirement. We encourage having taken an osteology course and having clear future goals. Interns are on their own for meals, transportation, and housing. In the past, interns have spent between \$1000-2000 for their stay.

Deadline for Submission:

Applications must be received by **February 15** to be considered for a summer internship position.

Internship Eligibility:

- Must be a full-time undergraduate or graduate student in Anthropology or related field.
- Must have had the vaccinations outlined in the application form.
- An osteology course is recommended.
- Must enroll in the Field Methods short course (May 29 to June 1). We reserve four spots for the interns to register upon acceptance into the program.
- Must be available throughout the entire required internship interval (May 29 – June 29, 2018).

Application Requirements:

- Interested students must complete the attached application and provide a cover letter that includes how their background and interests fit the program.
- A letter of recommendation from the applicant's advisor, or other faculty member who is familiar with the applicant's performance in the classroom, must be submitted in order for an application to be considered complete and subsequently reviewed.
